How is the program structured?

The TEFL certificate involves taking two courses. One is online, and the other is in a classroom.

- 1. The basic course, **Foundations in TEFL** (25 hours), is delivered in an online fixed-date format. This means that the instructor-led course has a definite start and end date, similar to classroom courses. As an online student, you will have access to your classroom at any time and can view your assignments, syllabus and course resources from any computer connected to the Internet.
- 2. The advanced course, **TEFL Immersion** (100 hours), is delivered in a classroom format where you can connect with your instructor and classmates in a live setting.
