

## Global Leadership Summer Program

Inspiring tomorrow's great leaders through a project-driven English program for teens

The Global Leadership Summer Program, beginning early July through mid-August, will not only provide students with an amazing academic experience, but also offer an opportunity to develop international friendships during an exciting, fun-filled summer! Students will use their new skills as they participate in field trips, sporting activities, and social events. The program provides:

- A curriculum designed to engage students through a variety of projects including debates, team presentations, and research, helping them to improve their communicative and leadership skills
- Afternoon Cultural Workshops, including sustainability
- Field trips that provide opportunities to interact with the local population to reinforce English and American culture
- Small class sizes with an average of 8 students, 10 maximum
- Flexible program options for a minimum of 2 weeks to a maximum of 6 weeks

Academic Schedule: Academically engaging, project-driven English language program 17.5 hours per week. Lessons are integrated with San Diego and southern California explorations to local attractions, such as San Diego Zoo, La Jolla Shores, Pacific Beach and more. In this unique program, students' experiences in the classroom and the community provide many opportunities to interact with the local population to reinforce English and American culture.

**Who Should Attend:** Non-native English speakers who are between the ages of 13 and 17

**Program Dates:** July - August, Monday-Friday, from 9:00 AM - 12:30 PM; arrive any Sunday for 2, 3, or 4 weeks
